FUNCTION AND APPLICATION: Light grade machine oil that lubricates and protects metal parts against wear, tarnish, rust and corrosion. Suggested for use on electrical motors, generators, industrial machines, refrigerators, vacuum cleaners, locks, hinges, casters, bicycles, typewriters, clocks, sewing machines, firearms and sporting equipment.

OUTSTANDING PROPERTIES: Meets U.S. Government Spec. MIL-L-644B for Lubricating Oil, General Purpose, Preservative (Water-Displacing, Low Temperature) oil. This product has a high flash point over 135°C and will not corrode or discolor sensitive metals such as copper, aluminum, and magnesium. Leaves no gumming or tackiness; prevents rusting by displacing water and forming a preservative film on metallic surfaces. Films of SOLDER SEAL® GUNK® SUPER OIL® are readily removable with naphtha, lighter fluid and other household solvents.

USE DIRECTIONS: Apply as needed to metal surfaces and mechanisms. May be spread on surfaces with cotton swabs or cloth.

PRODUCT LIMITATIONS: Will not provide a long-lasting protective film with one application. Repeat applications will be necessary. Not for use on food equipment. Will not provide adequate protection for heavy-duty machinery in continuous operation.
